Royal Statistical Society Publications

Originally called the Journal of the Statistical Society of London when founded in 1838 and renamed the Journal of the Royal Statistical Society when the Society was granted its Royal Charter in 1887, what is now known as Series A of the journal (Statistics in Society) is essentially a journal of general statistical interest. It publishes papers whose appeal lies in their subject-matter rather than their technical statistical content.

In 1887 it was renamed the Journal of the Royal Statistical Society (ISSN 0952-8385) when the society was granted a Royal Charter. On its centenary in 1934, the society inaugurated a Supplement to the Journal of the Royal Statistical Society to publish work on industrial and agricultural applications.
